



DELTA FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRE HAZARD ADVISORY Effective September 13, 2010

LOW FIRE RATING

In Delta we are now into a **LOW** fire danger rating.

No open burning will be allowed at any time in Delta with the exception of Metro Vancouver Regional District controlled fire pits on Deas Island Park and Boundary Bay.

Please be aware that if the fire rating changes the following may apply:

- All Burning Permits may be cancelled.
- Public to cease High risk activity between 1300 hrs and sunset each day.
- Should we experience three consecutive days of Extreme, all high risk activity ceases altogether.
- In consultation with the local municipal fire authority:
 - campfire restrictions or bans may be imposed at supervised campsites.
 - access restrictions may be imposed. (e.g. full closure guideline for the North Shore is three days of Extreme with no change predicted for the next three days.)
- **OBEY ALL SIGNS** – for example
 - “Extreme Fire Hazard Closed Area Stay Out”.
 - “Fire Hazard No Smoking Stay On Trails”.
